*Discover the secrets of the history of San Lazzaro degli Armeni*

In English it's San Lazzaro of the Armenians. This small island is located in the lagoon of Venice and is filled by the Monastery of these monks still reside in religious seclusion. It's off the beaten path but very much worth a visit. A bilingual guide will tell you details about the history of the place, its library, and its relationship with the poet Lord Byron. To get there, take the vaporetto leaving at 3:10 pm (there's only one departure per day).

*A stroll through the Giudecca Market followed by a delicious cocktail*

Just two vaporetto stops from St. Mark's Square, you'll find this peaceful haven where you can also enjoy one of the best views of the city. The beautiful landscape is irresistible to artists who like to stand on the shore to create their beautiful pictures. Another interesting fact: on this island you'll also find the famous Cip's Club, a bar and restaurant with an amazing terrace on the water where George Clooney himself designed a special cocktail.

*Trattoria Antiche Carampane. Not suitable for tourists*

The first thing that catches your attention at this restaurant is the sign at the entrance: "No Pizza, No Lasagna, No Tourist Menu." In short, if what you want is a quiet corner away from the crowd with quality food, this is your place. It specializes in fish and seafood, all served in a warm and friendly atmosphere. It is not easy to find, so you'll have to be vigilant.

*A pick-me-up in the Pasticceria Nobile*

The shop window full of delicious treats will captivate you and make you salivate. This is an excellent choice for a stop to regain your strength, offering a wide range of both sweets and savories. Their pizzette I must point out is magnificent, and you can eat it there or take it to go.

*Try authentic Spritz in All'Arco*

Of course, you simply cannot go to Venice and not try the Spritz, which is the classic aperitif of this city. In this bar located near the Rialto Bridge you can mingle with locals and tourists while lining up to grab a table so you can enjoy a good Spritz accompanied by typical Cichetti, the famous Italian tapas, at a great price.

*Hugs in a gondola*

There are few more romantic images than a couple in love standing on a gondola while traveling "La Serenissima" and holding hands. If you go to Venice, don't miss the opportunity to show your love through all the canals, at the pace of the gondolier. Keep in mind that prices vary depending on the time of day (it's more expensive in the afternoon) and it is important to negotiate the rate with the gondolier before you take off.
